



- Public sector participation is currently limited




CIA exams in Hungary

- Actually 35 CIAs in Hungary
- From May 2004 it is possible to take the exam in Hungarian (Part I, II, III)
- Exam site is unchanged since 2004
- Candidates from neighbouring countries
- Growing number of candidates sitting for the exam (highest number in 2004 due to the training organised by the Ministry of Finance)
- Exam results are getting better




Number of CIAs in Hungary
